**Curriculum Worksheet for the First Two Years (Effective September 2006)**

**OVERVIEW**

- The first two years of the business curriculum consist of General Education courses and business core courses.
- College of Business Administration students fulfill the General Education requirement in Mathematics with BUS 111; and in Social Science with ECN 201 and 202.
- The remaining General Education courses can be taken in either year.
- BUS 110 and BUS 111 may be taken in either semester or may be taken together.
- WRT 227 and the Free Elective may be taken in either semester.
- The language requirement can be met using any option as set forth below.
  - Option 1:** A two-course sequence (102 & 103) or (103 & 104) in a language studied for two or more years in high school.
  - Option 2:** A two-course sequence (101 & 102) in a language not studied in high school.
  - Option 3:** A single 3 credit course at the 104 level or higher.
- NOTE:** Study abroad may be used to complete the second semester requirement of a foreign language only under Option 1.
- Accounting** majors must complete one course from each of the following groups these courses do not need to be taken during the first two years.
  - Ethical Foundations** - PHL 212 as either a Letters or a free elective.
  - Political Foundations** - PSC 113, 116; or GEG 104 as a free elective.
- International Business** majors should enroll in PSC 116 instead of a second Natural Science course.

Sophomores who complete a minimum of 42 credits (General Education and Business Core) with an overall grade point average of 2.5 or higher and who complete; BUS 111, 201, 210; and ECN 201 (or equivalents) with a 2.7 or higher will be admitted after the first semester of the sophomore year. Students not qualifying after the first semester of their sophomore year must still meet the requirements of an overall grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 and have a GPA of 2.7 or higher in the following business core courses: BUS 111, 201, 202, 210, 211 and ECN 201 and 202.
